# **TRACK DAYS**

These events are usually held on a race circuit and are non-competitive. Track days are designed to give drivers the opportunity to test the full potential of their own vehicle's speed and handling abilities. You can use your own vehicle, be it your everyday family saloon or a track day special. This is a great chance to drive your vehicle at high speed under safe and controlled conditions, away from public roads.

## ROAD AND NAVIGATIONAL RALLYING

The Motorsports Group runs a number of different navigational rallies for you to get involved with, from 12 Car Rallies to Tulip Road Rallies. Road Rallying involves a driver and navigator finding their way around a set route from A to B. The emphasis is as much on navigation as driving skill, as crews must maintain a 30mph average time schedule through all the control points. The navigator may use Ordnance Survey maps to direct the driver around the route or possibly follow a Tulip Road Diagram. You must be very careful with timing – it's just as bad if you check in too early as it is to check in too late at a time control.

#### AUTOTESTS AND AUTOSOLOS

Autotests are usually held on grass. This is one of the slowest forms of motorsport, because you rarely need to get out of first or reverse gears. Autotesting demands a bit of skill, putting the emphasis on precision driving.

Autosolos are faster than Autotests and are usually held on tarmac. They're an ideal starting point for motorsports. You'll also get a chance to do some marshalling between tests, and don't forget, you must drive your own car to the event.
