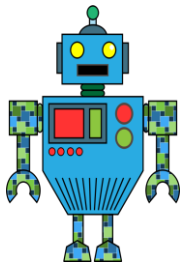

### **The Road to Ypres – Olive Edis**

Mary Olive Edis, born in London in 1876, had a studio in Church Street, Sheringham. She was one of the most important photographers of the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, and the first British woman to be appointed as an official war photographer in WW1, where she captured life away from the front line and concentrated on the human cost of war. She photographed the full spectrum of British society, from local north Norfolk fishermen and their families to royalty, prime ministers and artists. Alistair Murphy from Cromer Museum will tell us of her life and give a presentation of her work. This event is free for members and guests, with ample free parking, and there is no need to book in advance.
