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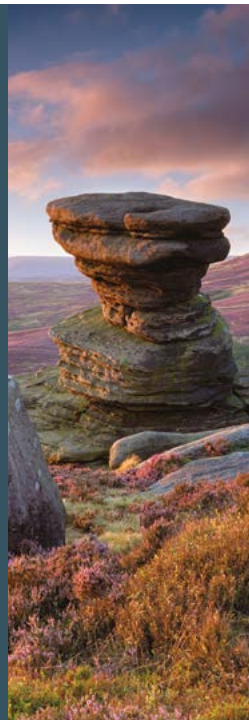

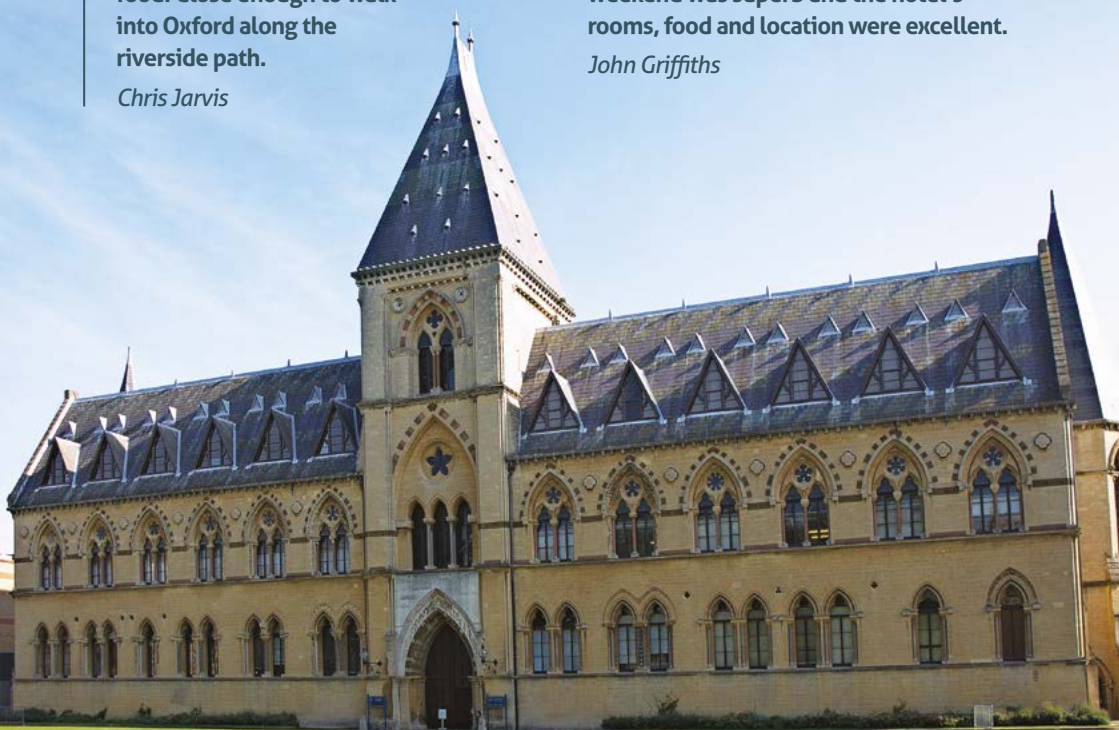

Get inspired in Oxford

Oxford is one of the oldest and most celebrated university cities in the world, but there are many other reasons why this beautiful city attracts over nine million visitors each year.

Oxford is also known for its museums including the Ashmolean, world famous for its art and archaeology. Another must-see is the University Museum of Natural History (above), which started life as the university's centre for scientific study but is now open to the public. You can get up close to thousands of rocks, minerals, fossils and zoological exhibits. Truly unmissable is the amazing Pitt Rivers Museum, where you'll find Japanese masks, Tahitian mourning clothes, Inuit parkas, African pottery, Hawaiian feather cloaks... The list goes on, and it's a fascinating collection, well worth a visit.

The Brookfield Hotel is located in Emsworth, a picturesque old fishing village at the north end of Chichester Harbour (pictured lower right). Its narrow streets, Georgian houses, walled gardens and pretty millpond make it a popular destination for sailors, artists and naturalists, and its waterside views attract visitors from far and wide.

The hotel is a family-owned country house, surrounded by its own landscaped gardens, offering traditionally-styled bedrooms.

Transport links are excellent, with the 700 bus service to Portsmouth or Chichester stopping just outside the hotel. The local railway station is only a mile away, making day trips to Brighton, Portsmouth and Southampton super easy.

**Price £219 for a twin or double room per person. Single room supplement is available for £25 per person extra (three nights £75).*

An additional night on Sunday would cost £90 per person or £105 for a single person with room supplement.

Emsworth is an ideal base for visiting local attractions such as the South Downs National Park or Portsmouth Historic Dockyard, home of HMS *Victory* and Henry VIII's *Mary Rose*.

You can also explore the bustling city of Chichester and its cathedral, famous for its 600-year-old spire. Want to go even further back in time? King Henry's picturesque Arundel Castle is nearby, and the Roman palace at Fishbourne is the largest residential Roman building yet discovered in Britain.

The best of Chester

Chester is an ancient place and its historic streets – protected by the most complete city walls in Britain – are fascinating to explore. The River Dee meanders through the heart of the city and makes a relaxing riverside walk with its picturesque bridges.

The city's cathedral is well worth a visit, and shopping lovers won't want to miss the world-famous Rows (above), black and white half-timbered buildings with splendid two-tier medieval galleries.

Chester Zoo is set in 125 acres of zoological gardens and there are some 35,000 animals to see. You can also learn about some critically endangered species, such as orangutans, lemurs and lions.

If you fancy a trip to a National Trust property, Erdigg Hall and Chirk Castle are nearby, and Tatton Park is 40 minutes away by car. With its 50 acres of landscaped gardens, it makes a lovely day out and the estate's Stables Restaurant is available for coffee or lunch.

Join us for a two-night break at the Old Swan Hotel in the Victorian spa town of Harrogate. With the beautiful Yorkshire Dales on the doorstep, this is a great location for exploring the river valleys, hills and woodlands in the surrounding countryside.

Dating back to the 1840s, the Old Swan is right in the centre of town and offers comfortable accommodation and bags of character. It was certainly good enough for writer Agatha Christie – when she mysteriously disappeared for 11 days in 1926 it was here that she was eventually tracked down.

Tales of the Dales

Located in the heart of the beautiful Yorkshire Dales, Harrogate was the place to be in the 1800s, when the high society of Victorian Britain would come to take the air and enjoy therapeutic spa treatments. People come to Harrogate today for similar reasons – relaxation and indulgence, plus some quality shopping and, of course, afternoon tea!

Out and about, the Mercer Art Gallery and Royal Pump Room Museum are just a short walk from the hotel in the elegant Montpellier Quarter, the cultural heart of the town. The Grade 2 listed Valley Gardens are also nearby – well worth a visit for the charming Japanese garden.

Out of town, head to RHS Harlow Carr gardens at Beckwithshaw, where you can wander through 58 acres of tranquil beauty getting inspiration for your own green space. 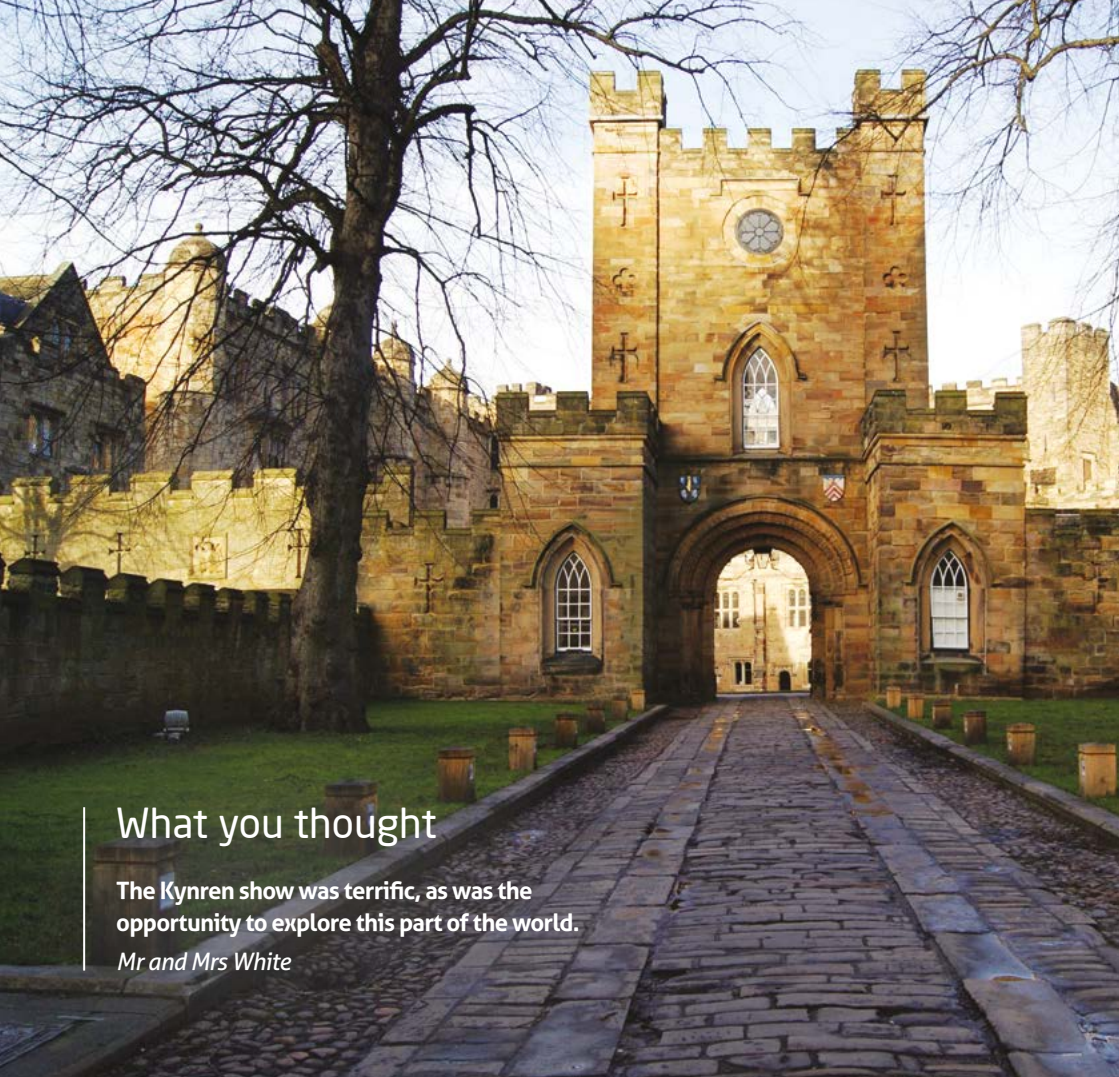

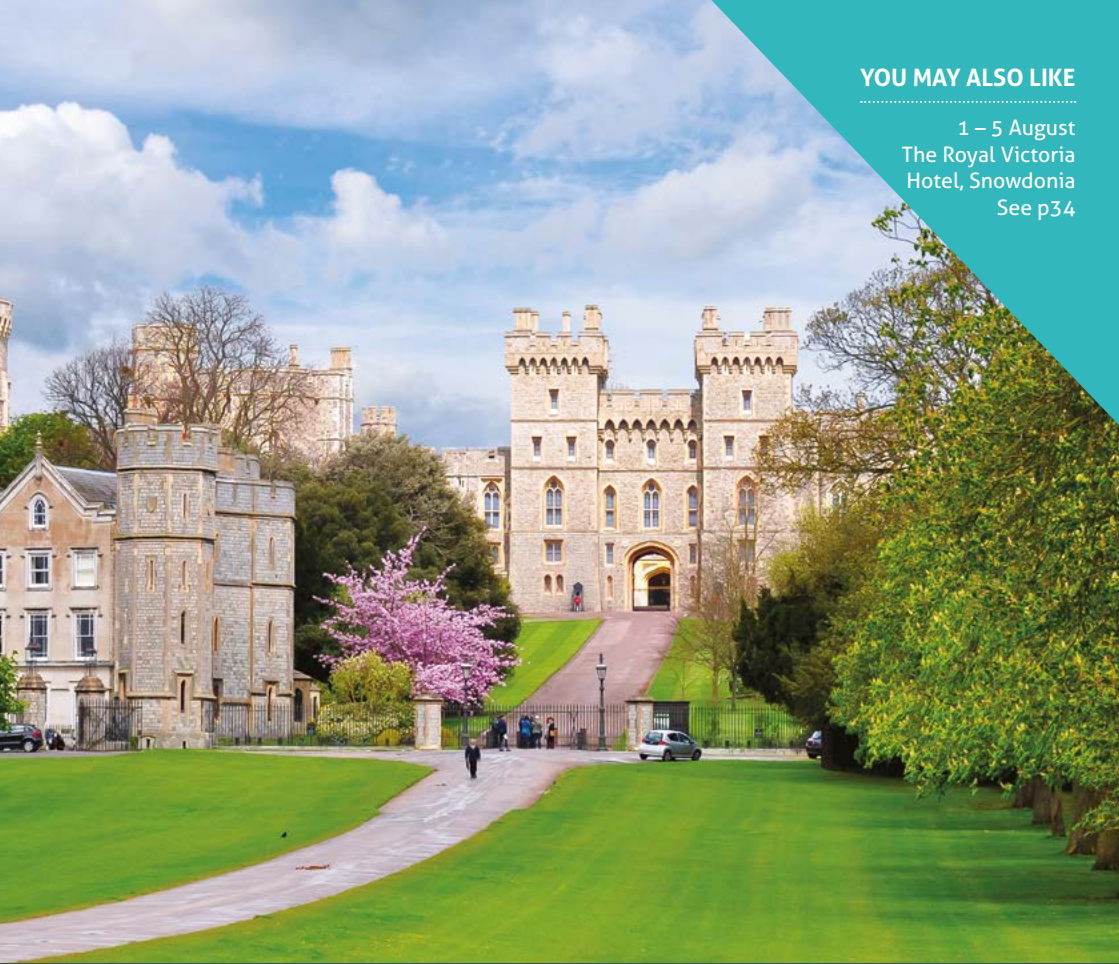

Windsor and surrounding attractions

Windsor is host to many formal state events, ceremonial occasions and visits from foreign dignitaries. St George's Hall makes a spectacular setting for state banquets, when a table seating 160 guests is decorated with porcelain and silver gilt from the Royal Collection.

Since 1660, Windsor Castle has also performed its own changing of the guard. To this day, this event takes place in the quadrangle outside the Royal Apartments when the Queen is in residence.

Also worth a visit, Syon House is the last surviving ducal residence complete with its country estate in Greater London. Take a look round the Duke of Northumberland's London home, view the magnificent state and private apartments and enjoy the spectacular Great Conservatory and 40 acres of gardens.

And, at Kew Gardens, discover the world of science behind the botanical collections, with over 50,000 living plants to be found across this UNESCO World Heritage site.

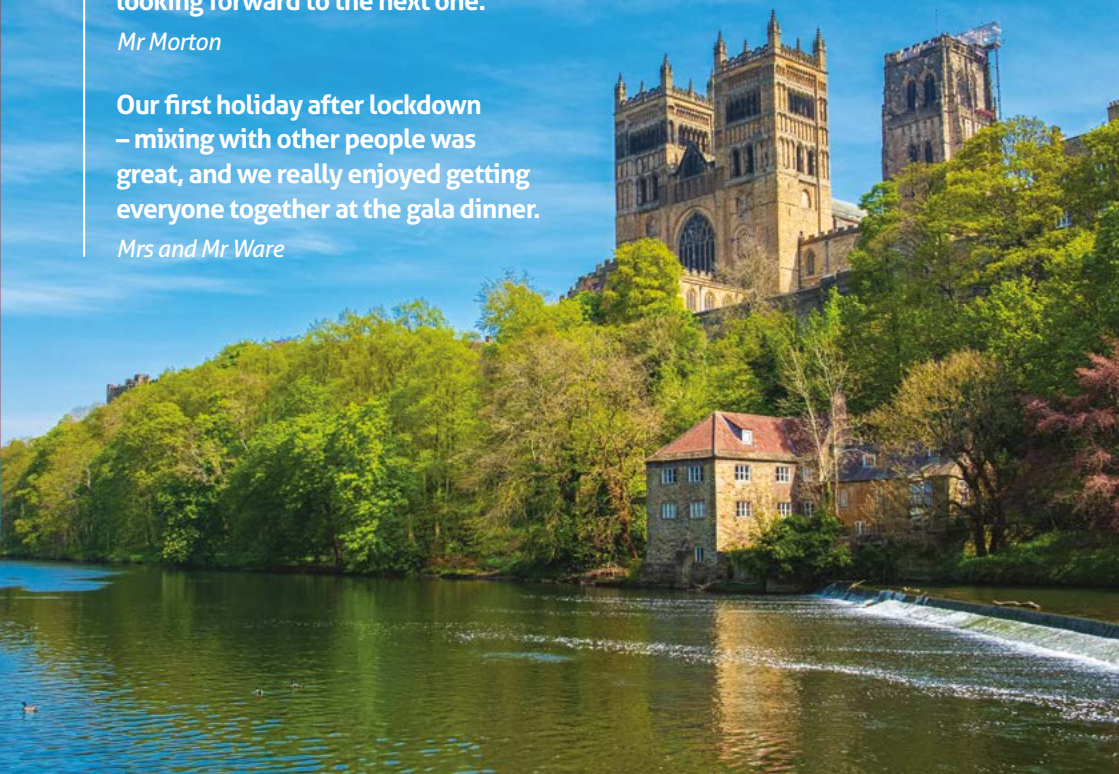
